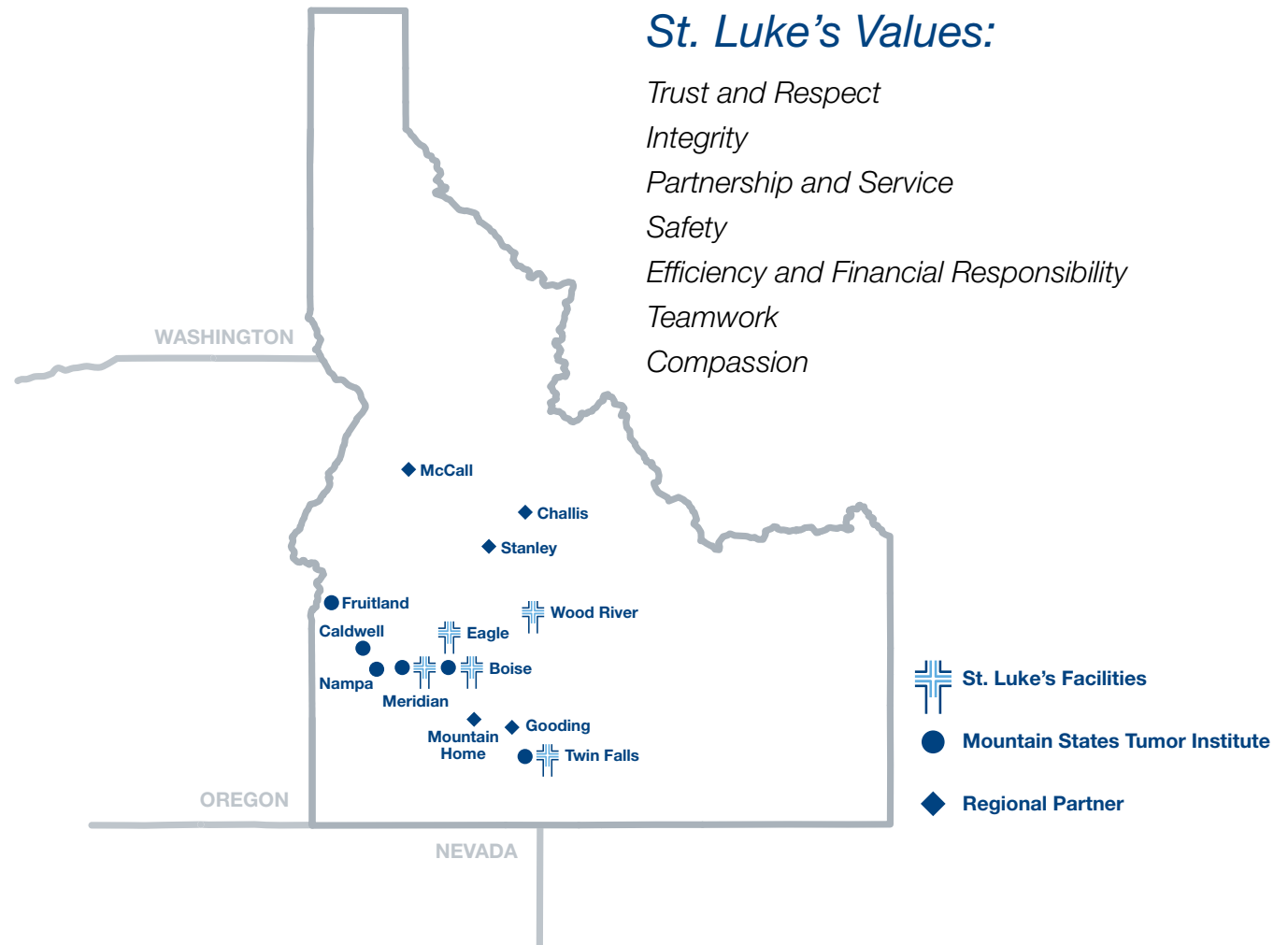

Committed to our communities

The strength of St. Luke's lies in the unique qualities of our four hospitals and the communities we serve, backed up by the resources and support of our entire health system. This has led to increased research capability at St. Luke's Mountain States Tumor Institute (MSTI), providing greater opportunities for patients to participate in clinical trials.

One of these patients is five-year-old Kade Andrew, who was diagnosed with acute lymphocytic (lymphoblastic) leukemia, or ALL, in April 2007. Kade is currently enrolled in two clinical trials through St. Luke's MSTI. His mom, Stephanie, says the hope of a cure for Kade's ALL isn't the only benefit to enrolling him in clinical trials. She also feels a responsibility to the families who come after them.

"If these trials can help someone else down the road, you have to do it," she says. "If it wasn't for the families who participated before us, we might not be here today."

Families like Kade's inspire us every day. They and all the people we serve can expect an even higher level of care as St. Luke's evolves, thanks to clinical staff working together to develop best practices, and consolidation and standardization that enhance seamless transitions across our health care system.

This interconnectedness is the hallmark of our system. From patients evacuated from St. Luke's Wood River to Boise and Magic Valley during 2007's Castle Rock fire, to the crews of *Air St. Luke's* transporting critical patients from bases in Boise and Twin Falls, to the expansion of Home Care and Hospice offices throughout the region, our communities benefit when they know they will receive a St. Luke's experience at every St. Luke's facility.

We know that healthy communities begin with healthy citizens, and every day that Kade can play football with his family or spend a morning at preschool is a good day for us all.

EXCELLENCE

Bright minds, big hearts

Nikkie Stephens and Brad Rider spent a lot of time at St. Luke's Boise in 2007. Kelly Sparks and Matt Olsen traveled frequently to St. Luke's Wood River. Throughout the year these respiratory therapists (RTs) from St. Luke's Magic Valley filled in where they were needed during staffing shortages. Already experienced RTs, they increased their knowledge and skills while relieving the pressure on their colleagues at St. Luke's system hospitals.

"My education really grew by working in the Children's Hospital NICU," says Nikkie. "And I have tried to bring what I learned to my work in Twin Falls."

Being a part of the growing St. Luke's system has broadened the opportunities for our 7,400 employees. Staff members can transfer and advance through a larger organization, work in more than one location or department, and train in a "sister" hospital to develop their skills. They serve as a bridge between hospitals, solidifying relationships and developing best practices with their colleagues throughout the system.

For example, St. Luke's Wood River Labor and Delivery nurses train at St. Luke's Boise, where they will experience more births in one day than they normally see in one month. They also work with St. Luke's Children's Hospital and Maternal Fetal Medicine physicians in caring for high-risk mothers and infants. Boise nurses have also worked at Wood River. They gain new perspective in the broad range of clinical roles that a nurse in a small community hospital has to play, leading to shared understanding and appreciation by staff at both hospitals.

With nearly 52,000 applications received for 1,700 open positions last year, we have the opportunity to select the very best staff. At St. Luke's we expect a lot of our people. Clinical and technical excellence is the minimum standard. What distinguishes St. Luke's is the compassion and the personal touch that employees like Nikkie, Brad, Kelly, and Matt demonstrate every day to every patient who comes through our doors.

TRUST

Improving patient safety

Siaya Flores was born with gastroschisis, an opening in her abdominal wall through which her bowel extended outside her body. Her mother, Sandra Gonzalez, was referred to St. Luke's Boise by her physicians in Twin Falls when the baby's condition was diagnosed in utero.

Siaya spent two months in St. Luke's Children's Hospital's Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU) following surgery when she was just hours old. Siaya and Sandra are now back home in Buhl, and Siaya will receive follow-up care with pediatric specialists at the Children's Hospital and St. Luke's Magic Valley. Her prognosis is very good.

Constantly improving safety is vital to improving medical outcomes for young patients like Siaya. And although St. Luke's rates very well when compared with national averages, we continue to develop and refine procedures at all facilities to enhance safety and provide an even better experience for every patient.

Comparing four hospitals of different sizes and complexities is not easy, but St. Luke's is working to ensure consistency across our clinical practices so patients at each of our facilities has access to the same high standard of care.

Current data shows that at St. Luke's, invasive infection rates for methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA) are among the lowest in the country; post-operative infection rates for selected elective surgeries monitored nationally are well below national rates; and obstetric complications are approximately 50 percent lower than the national average. St. Luke's has a long record of excellence in patient care, and our numbers bear that out, but there is still work to do. Our goal is to bring our patient outcomes to as close to perfect as possible.

But numbers don't give us the whole picture – there are very real people behind the data, people like Sandra and Siaya. They tell our story far better than any numbers ever could.

INNOVATION

Physician leadership in health care

“American health care is the envy of much of the world,” says family medicine physician Kurt Seppi, MD. “We have highly skilled, committed professionals, state-of-the-art institutions, and the latest innovations in biomedical research, technology, and treatment.”

At the same time, he says, American health care is fragmented and expensive, and can be difficult to access.

Dr. Seppi believes that health care quality and efficiency can be improved only if physicians join together and work with hospitals, health plan providers, employers, and health care consumers.

For nearly a decade, Dr. Seppi and other Magic Valley physicians have collaborated to provide a unified voice in their community. The physicians twice rallied against bringing a for-profit hospital into the Magic Valley, a move the physicians believed would have seriously hurt local health care.

They have joined with St. Luke’s Magic Valley in a collaborative effort dedicated to building patient partnerships by preventing illness and injury and providing high quality, cost-effective medical care. Together, they measure clinical data for quality improvement, promote consistency in contracting with third-party payers, and have developed an electronic medical records system.

Physicians and hospitals working together across St. Luke’s Health System increase efficiency and reduce costs through streamlined inventory, reduction of duplicated equipment, competitive prices from vendors, and the ability to negotiate reimbursement rates based on quality and values. Physician involvement is critical in establishing best practices and achieving certification and accreditation of labs and centers.

Dr. Seppi sees the benefits of collaboration every day. As one of the founding members of the “St. Luke’s Clinic” model of health care, he and his fellow physicians are in private practice, but their front office and nursing staff are St. Luke’s Magic Valley employees.

“St. Luke’s manages our practice much more efficiently than we could, from hiring staff to handling our billing,” he says. “It has freed us up to spend more time on patient care, and has led to improved access for our patients.”

Nurses dedicated to healing

From assisting new mothers to providing comfort to patients with terminal cancer, St. Luke's nurses are an indispensable part of the care we provide. When it comes to healing, the relationship between nurse and patient is vital. The more than 2,000 nurses at St. Luke's specialize in clinical excellence, patient safety, and compassionate care. They are dedicated caregivers and advocates for patients and families.

One of these nurses is Angela Brady, an Emergency Department nurse at St. Luke's Wood River.

"I always knew I was meant to be a nurse," Angela says. "My mother, aunt, and sister are all nurses – it runs deep in our veins. I feel it is a gift given to me to share with others."

Nurses like Angela share their tremendous gifts with all of us, as patients, colleagues, and members of the community. Our nurses' dedication to their profession has earned St. Luke's Boise/Meridian the state's first redesignation as a Magnet hospital – national recognition for quality patient care, nursing excellence, and innovations in professional nursing practice. St. Luke's has adopted Magnet standards at all our facilities, with the goal of achieving Magnet status at each hospital.

St. Luke's continues to create an environment that attracts and retains highly qualified nurses and supports them in their educational and career pursuits. Angela's commitment extends to many areas of nursing. She is a sexual assault nurse examiner, designated Emergency Department charge nurse, and certified chemotherapy nurse. She provides community education, is a clinical instructor, and serves as a resource for all areas of the hospital.

A nurse for nearly 22 years, Angela has cared for and comforted countless patients.

"So many people have touched me over the years," she says. "They give me so much more than I could ever give them."

RESPONSIBILITY

Making the most of our resources

As a community-owned, not-for-profit health care system, financial responsibility and efficiency are critical to fulfilling the St. Luke's mission. Our goal is to keep costs as low as possible without sacrificing excellence in care.

The cost of supplies is our second largest expense, trailing only the cost of labor. Yet, joining our facilities to create St. Luke's Health System has already led to savings as we share resources and purchase supplies in volume. In 2007 we realized a savings of \$580,000 on contracts for custom surgical packs and implantable cardiology products.

St. Luke's Supply Chain Management professionals are currently gathering and aligning our data to reassess every dollar of the \$120 million we spend on supplies each year. Then, category by category and contract by contract, we will renegotiate with vendors based on our new market share numbers.

Achieving cost savings on supplies means nothing if clinicians don't want to use them. That's why purchasing managers work with physician groups to gather input. Bringing physician expertise to the table when it comes to purchases of supplies and advanced medical equipment ensures that patients receive only the very best.

When it comes to standardizing purchasing and utilization across the health system, efficiency means not reinventing the wheel. Processes that are working at one St. Luke's facility can be applied across the system. As we continue to identify opportunities and monitor achievement, our cost savings will continue to grow. The more fiscally responsible we are, the more these savings can be reinvested in the programs, technology, and services that will help us provide the best care for the people of our region.

GENEROSITY

Volunteers give of themselves

“It’s an exciting time to be a part of St. Luke’s,” says Arthur F. “Skip” Oppenheimer, chairman and CEO of Oppenheimer Companies and chairman of St. Luke’s Health System Board of Directors. “We are building on the great reputation of St. Luke’s through the evolution of the health care system and the pursuit of some very visionary initiatives.”

St. Luke's further expanded our services and facilities this year to meet the needs of the growing Treasure Valley. 2007 saw continued construction of St. Luke's Eagle, which opened in April 2008 with urgent care, medical imaging, laboratory services, physician offices, and more. We are preparing to build and open a cardiac rehabilitation center, and are adding 67 new patient rooms at St. Luke's Boise and Meridian.

As full service, locally governed hospitals, we are accountable to our communities – not to shareholders. We strive to be knowledgeable, ethical stewards of the resources entrusted to us by building regional partnerships and providing community programs, medical facilities, advanced technology, and high quality health care to all people, regardless of their ability to pay.

Thanks to the judicious use of resources and the generosity of our donors, we have added three fully integrated, state-of-the-art operating rooms at St. Luke's Boise, and installed full-field digital mammography equipment at five Breast Cancer Detection Center sites in the Treasure Valley. Our Mother Baby Care Unit in Boise was completely remodeled, and St. Luke's Meridian is now home to a Level II Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU).

Participation in national safety initiatives has led to standardized procedures that have increased patient safety. For the first time, all three of our adult Critical Care Units were free of VAP (ventilator-associated pneumonia) for six months, and Rapid Response Teams have been implemented in St. Luke's Children's Hospital.


The hard work and ongoing commitment of our employees resulted in several prestigious awards. St. Luke's Meridian Emergency Department earned a VHA Improvement Award for Operational Excellence; St. Luke's Mountain States Tumor Institute (MSTI) was awarded the Idaho Hospital Association's Citation for Meritorious Service; and St. Luke's Center for Breast Imaging was recognized as the only Breast Imaging Center of Excellence in Idaho by the American College of Radiology and the Society of Breast Imaging.

St. Luke's Magic Valley serves south central Idaho and northern Nevada in a way that respects our patients and community residents – by listening, including them in decisions, and growing the services and facilities to support advanced care and treatment as close to home as possible. In return, community partnerships and forward-thinking individuals working together have helped us bring a high level of technology and advanced care to the area, demonstrating their strong commitment to our hospital.

For 90 years, Magic Valley residents have trusted our physicians, nurses, staff, and community leaders for the promise of quality health care. In 2007, St. Luke's Magic Valley continued to deliver on this promise by opening St. Luke's Women's Center, St. Luke's Imaging Center, and our Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit (a partnership between St. Luke's and Idaho Elks Rehabilitation); and by breaking ground on our new 177-bed hospital and medical office building at the corner of Grandview and Poleline in Twin Falls.

We have maintained distinguished credentials from national organizations, including the Joint Commission and the Commission on Cancer.


We joined the Institute for Healthcare Improvement's national *5 Million Lives* campaign, implementing evidence-based best practices to improve outcomes and patient safety. The *900 Women* campaign brought together health care providers and resources from across the region to improve mammography rates.

Fundamentally, our goals are centered on preparing for the future health care needs of the community while enhancing services to those we serve today. Partnerships are a key factor in the success of St. Luke's Magic Valley. Working with Twin Falls county high schools, the College of Southern Idaho, and other educational institutions, students can experience health care professions early on, within the hospital. Through programs ranging from school health and safety fairs to coalitions such as Safe Kids Magic Valley and services such as CARES (Children at Risk Evaluation Services), we work to build stronger families, help residents make informed decisions about their health, and provide peace of mind and improved quality of life.

From the day St. Luke's Wood River opened its doors in 2000, the expertise and commitment of our staff, the array of comprehensive services available, and the quality of care our patients receive, has continued to grow and advance.

Today, we can all be proud of the many accomplishments we have made together, as a team and as part of St. Luke's Health System, to make St. Luke's Wood River so special – particularly the caring staff, expert physicians, dedicated volunteers, and state-of-the-art technology we have in our small hospital. We would like to take this opportunity to highlight just a few of the many reasons we are well on our way to achieving our vision of becoming "America's Finest Community Hospital."

- Accreditation by the American College of Radiology in mammography, ultrasound, MRI, and CT, and soon in nuclear medicine.
- A dramatic decline in employee turnover in 2007, from 14 percent to 8.48 percent, thanks to efforts to improve our retention and recruitment programs. The national average for hospitals is 14 percent.
- We are so fortunate and thankful for the philanthropic support we receive. The Foundation raised more than \$2.1 million in calendar year 2007, a 57 percent increase in funds raised and a 43 percent increase in the number of donors, compared to 2006. Thanks to this support, we now have two integrated operating rooms, with high-definition cameras and monitors and other advanced technology that is almost unheard of in hospitals our size.
- To meet the needs of our growing community and our family medicine physicians, we purchased two acres in Hailey and anticipate breaking ground this summer on a new 25,000 square foot medical facility.

As we begin our strategic planning process for fiscal years 2009 and 2010, our team will again focus on identifying and addressing the health care needs of our community. As the only hospital in Blaine County, we take our role seriously and strive to provide comprehensive, high quality services. Whether it's an emergency injury or illness, a simple outpatient test, a same-day surgery, or a specialty service, residents and visitors alike can rest assured that they will receive superior care at St. Luke's Wood River.

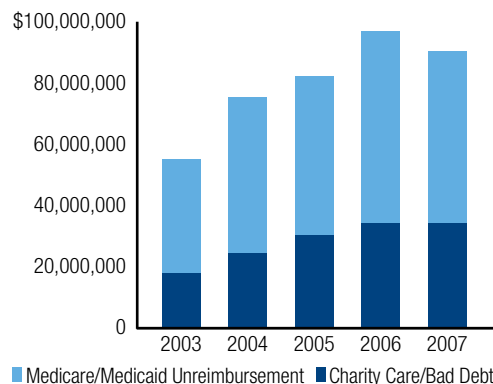


More than \$390,000 was awarded during the year to support staff and community education, medical equipment, and health-related programs. Additionally, three new endowments were established by bequests and by current donors.


